

Final Examination Exemption

RATIONALE

The purpose of evaluation and assessment is to ensure that students have the Knowledge, Skills and Attitudes to further their education. Students who have worked to achieve honor marks in each course should be commended for their efforts as their grades reflect readiness for the next level of learning.

Guidelines and Procedures

- Guideline:** Students who have an 80% or better prior to their final examination, may be recommended. This means that the student may choose to write the final examination but is not required to do so. If a student chooses to write the final examination after being recommended, and the exam result is lower than the student's recommended mark, the recommended mark will stand.
- Procedures:** Teachers will provide a list of students and the grade (mark) who are being recommended prior to the final examination to the Counselor / Administration when requested.
